Shared Equipment Rules

The sheds at Marine West (batting cage) and Manhattan Heights have the following equipment available for teams practicing/playing on those fields:

2 buckets each of 10" (6U/MP/8U), 11" (10U) and 12" (12U) practice balls

2 hitting nets

2 Tanner tees

If there is only one team using the field, they may use all available equipment. If sharing space (or warming up before a game), each team is limited to 1 tee, 1 net, and 1 bucket of balls.

All equipment must be returned to the shed after use. Coaches with late practice times should ensure that all equipment is returned to the shed and the shed is locked. Coaches at Marine should ensure that batting cage gate is locked.

Batting Cage Rules

- Pitching machines may only be used under adult supervision.
- Machines are only to be used during league sanctioned activity (i.e. practice)
- Pitching machines are not open to the public. A coach must be present.
- Balls must be picked up after use and returned to bins/buckets. Bins/buckets must be covered.
- Cover pitching machines after use.
- Unplug extension cords.
- Turn lights off after use.
- Lock gate after use.
- Absolutely no metal spikes.

Any coach/team found to have violated the above Batting Cage Rules will be barred from future use.
